A candidate must receive a majority of the votes, with a runoff provision, in order to win the race.

To determine the majority:

1. Divide the total vote count, including write-ins, by the number of seats to be filled.

63 divided by 2 = 31.50

2. Divide 31.50 by 2 = 15.75

3. Add one to 15.75 = 16.75 (always round up if necessary)

The majority is 17.
