Summer hire positions

I am requesting the authority to hire two temporary equipment operators for a period not to exceed 120 days. One would be used as a loader operator supporting our gravel road improvement program. One would be operating a roadside mower replacing the normal operator who is out on extended medical leave. We would also leave the two remaining summer hire positions that are vacant to help make up the wages for these employees.

Usually, we pay the union scale rate for a new equipment operator for positions of this type. Since we are not planning to have them drive trucks and therefore not requiring a CDL, I would propose a pay rate of \$23-25 per hour, depending on experience.
