A RESOLUTION CALLING UPON THE IOWA ATTORNEY GENERAL TO FULLY INVESTIGATE THE ACTIVITIES OF WOODBURY COUNTY SUPERVISOR JEREMY TAYLOR AND HIS WIFE KIM PHOUNG TAYLOR DURING THE JUNE 2, 2020 PRIMARY ELECTION, THE JULY 7, 2020 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DISTRICT 2 SPECIAL ELECTION AND THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Kim Phoung Taylor, the wife of Woodbury County Supervisor Jeremy Taylor was arrested January 12, 2023 by federal authorities for her role in an alleged voter fraud scheme during the 2020 Primary and General Elections and

WHEREAS, Woodbury County Supervisor Jeremy Taylor was named as as an unindicted co-conspirator in the government’s trial memorandum filed November 6, 2023 and

WHEREAS, it was stated in the government’s trial memorandum filed November 6, 2023, former Woodbury County Supervisor Rocky De Witt and Woodbury County Sheriff Chad Sheehan as candidates during the 2020 Primary and General Elections were anticipated to testify that Jeremy Taylor said he had a “lock” on a substantial number of votes from the Vietnamese community in Sioux City and

WHEREAS, Woodbury County Auditor Patrick Gill testified he observed Jeremy Taylor and Kim Phoung Taylor, together, dropping off voting materials at a Woodbury County ballot drop box and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2023, Kim Phoung Taylor was convicted in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Iowa Western Division of fifty-two counts of voter fraud and

WHEREAS, evidence exists that the same activity took place during the July 7, 2020 Board of Supervisors District 2 Special Election that was not investigated by federal authorities,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED the Woodbury County Board of Supervisors, hereby request the Iowa Attorney General conduct a thorough investigation of the activities of Woodbury County Supervisor Jeremy Taylor and his wife Kim Phoung Taylor during the June 2, 2020 Primary Election, the July 7, 2020 Board of Supervisors District 2 Special Election, and the November 3, 2020 General Election and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if warranted, the Woodbury County Board of Supervisors request the Iowa Attorney General file a petition for removal of Jeremy Taylor from the office of Woodbury County Supervisor.
